

## ABOUT THE COMPETITION

VAM presents its 8th annual VAM Intermediate Symphony Concerto Competition providing an opportunity for up to three soloists to perform a movement of a concerto with the VAM Intermediate Symphony.\*

VAM will ensure that the competition is impartially and professionally conducted with a two-person adjudication panel consisting of experienced musicians with no affiliation with the competing musicians.

\*performance date to be assigned by conductor

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

Eligible students:

- are currently members in good standing of VAM Intermediate Symphony;
- are not winners of the VAMIS 2022/23 Concerto Competition.

#### **DATES**

Application Deadline: September 25, 2023, 11:59pm Competition: October 16, 2023

Students will receive notice of their specific time slot following the application deadline.

#### **TO APPLY**

#### **COMPETITION RULES**

- 1. Students must perform on the instrument they currently play in VAMIS.
- 2. The selection must be approved by VAMIS conductor Joseph Elworthy and meet length, orchestration and proficiency requirements. Repertoire approval will be confirmed within 3 business days of the application deadline.
- 3. Students must provide 2 copies of the solo part or piano reduction for the adjudication committee (photocopies are permitted).
- 4. Performers must perform from memory.
- 5. Performers must perform with and provide their own pianist.
- The competition phase is closed to the public with the exception of the parent/guardian and teacher of the student performing; no video or audio recording permitted.
- Repertoire selections must not exceed 15
  minutes in duration. For the competition,
  tutti passages must be shortened.
- 8. All applications must include a \$60 application fee, which includes recording of the competition round.
- 1 winner awarded the Orpheum Prize performs at the Orpheum Theatre; 2 winners awarded the VAM Prize will perform at VAM.
- 10. By applying to the competition, the student and parent/guardian agree that any resulting recordings may be used for VAM's promotional purposes.
