

COMPETITION RULES

- 1. Students must perform on the instrument they currently play in VAMJS.
- 2. The selection must be approved by VAMJS conductor Joseph Elworthy and meet length, orchestration and proficiency requirements. Repertoire approval will be confirmed within 3 business days of the application deadline.
- 3. Students must provide 2 copies of the solo part or piano reduction for the adjudication committee (photocopies are permitted).
- 4. Performers must perform from memory.
- 5. Performers must perform with and provide their own pianist.
- 6. The competition phase is closed to the public with the exception of the parent/guardian and teacher of the student performing; no video or audio recording permitted.
- 7. Repertoire selections must not exceed 15 minutes in duration. For the competition, tutti passages must be shortened.
- 8. All applications must include a \$60 application fee, which includes recording of the competition round.
- 9. 1 winner awarded the Orpheum Prize performs at the Orpheum Theatre; 2 winners awarded the VAM Prize will perform at VAM.
- By applying to the competition, the student and parent/guardian agree that any resulting recordings may be used for VAM's promotional purposes.
