VAM presents its 10th annual VAM Intermediate Symphony Concerto Competition providing an opportunity for up to three soloists to perform a movement of a concerto with the VAM Intermediate Symphony. * VAM will ensure that the competition is impartially and professionally conducted with a two-person adjudication panel consisting of experienced musicians with no affiliation with the competing musicians.

Competition dates: October 20, 2025

*Students will receive notice of their specific time slot following the application deadline.

Eligibility

Eligible students:

- •are currently members in good standing of VAM Intermediate Symphony;
- •are not winners of the VAMIS 2024/25 Concerto Competition.

Competition Rules

- 1. Students must perform on the instrument they currently play in VAMIS.
- 2. The selection must be approved by the Orchestra Manager and meet length, orchestration and proficiency requirements. Repertoire approval will be confirmed within 3 business days of the application deadline.
- 3. If the selected repertoire requires performance licensing or copyright clearance, the student is responsible for any associated costs if chosen as a winner and invited to perform.
- 4. Students must provide 2 copies of the solo part or piano reduction for the adjudication committee (photocopies are permitted).
- 5. Performers must perform from memory.
- 6. Performers must perform with and provide their own pianist.
- 7. The competition phase is closed to the public with the exception of the parent/guardian and teacher of the student performing; no video or audio recording permitted.
- 8. Repertoire selections must not exceed 8 minutes in duration. For the competition, tutti passages must be shortened.
- 9. All applications must include a non-refundable \$60 application fee.
- 10. 1 winner awarded the Chan Centre Prize performs at the Chan Centre; 2 winners awarded the VAM Prize will perform at VAM.
- 11. By applying to the competition, the student and parent/guardian agree that any resulting recordings from the winner's performance with VAM Intermediate Symphony may be used for VAM's promotional purposes.
