- Focus will be mainly on vocal technique, role preparation, and some movement/choreography.
- Tuition: \$750 (non-refundable deposit of \$300 required by April 1st)

- Prepare 2 contrasting songs: (1) Any song from the Andrew Lloyd Webber repertoire (2) Any song from musical of your choice
- Held at the Vancouver Academy of Music (1270 Chestnut Street)
- A pianist will be provided (please ensure you have a cleanly printed hard copy of the sheet music in the appropriate key)
- If you would like to sing along to a karaoke track, you will need to bring the song already prepared on an electronic device ready to be plugged into a speaker.
- **Star Performer:**
 - NO AUDITION REQUIRED, but a placement interview is needed to determine vocal range and pitch accuracy. To be held closer to the start of the program.
 - Casting mainly ensemble roles within the Webber Revue + solos and ensembles within an additional side revue concert.
 - A great option for people who love to sing, want to build vocal confidence and make new friends.
 - Tuition: \$550 (non-refundable deposit of \$300 required by April 1st)
