VAM will ensure that the competition is impartially and professionally conducted with a two-person adjudication panel consisting of experienced musicians with no affiliation with the competing musicians.

ELIGIBILITY

Eligible students:

- are currently members in good standing of VAM Junior Symphony;
- are not winners of the VAMJS 2018/19 Concerto Competition.

Application Deadline: October 7, 2019, 11:59pm

Competition: October 21, 2019

Students will receive notice of their specific time slot following the application deadline.

COMPETITION RULES

1. Students must perform on the instrument they currently play in VAMJS.
2. The selection must be approved by VAMJS conductor Joseph Elworthy and meet length, orchestration and proficiency requirements. Repertoire approval will be confirmed within 3 business days of the application deadline.
3. Students must provide 2 copies of the solo part or piano reduction for the adjudication committee (photocopies are permitted).
4. Performers must perform from memory.
5. Performers must perform with and provide their own accompanist.
6. The competition phase is closed to the public with the exception of the parent/guardian and teacher of the student performing; no video or audio recording permitted.
7. Repertoire selections must not exceed 15 minutes in duration. For the competition, tutti passages must be shortened.
8. All applications must include a \$20 application fee.
