Online Learning Plan for Suzuki Violin Performance Classes

The online adaptation for Suzuki Violin Performance classes continues to focus on Dr. Suzuki's emphasis on learning to play music together to create a sense of community. Remote online instruction will be available to those who have internet connection, a device such as a computer or tablet, a webcam and microphone.

Using Zoom as the delivery platform, classes maintain the importance of parental help, but the role parents play may decrease as their children mature. Classes will involve exploration and review of common repertoire, activities for learning musical form, music theory, music history, violin techniques, ear training skills, and strengthening of relationships between students and parents.

Despite the online format, students are given opportunities to engage in solo performances, take on leadership roles, and to learn effective communication skills.
