# ABOUT THE COMPETITION

The Vancouver Academy of Music BassFest Competition is designed to identify talented bass students and afford them recognition and financial assistance. One adjudicator external to VAM will evaluate contestants with \$3,000 in total scholarships awarded for select 2023/24 VAM programs.

## ELIGIBILITY

Bass students up to the age of 18 as of June 26, 2023 are eligible to participate. This competition is open to both VAM and non-VAM students.

## SCHOLARSHIPS

Up to three \$500 scholarships awarded to students in each category. Receiving a scholarship does not guarantee admission into programs that require additional entrance requirements.

- Ages 15-18
- Ages 14 and under

## DATES

Application Deadline: May 22, 2023, 11:59pm

Competition: June 26, 2023\*

## COMPETITION RULES

1. Applications are subject to a fee of \$60 made payable to the Vancouver Academy of Music, which includes recording of the competition round. No other audio or video recording is permitted.
2. Applicants must prepare two contrasting selections with a maximum duration of 15 minutes or less, performed by memory.
3. Students must provide their own pianist.
4. A copy of the music must be provided for the adjudicator (photocopies permitted).
5. The competition phase will be closed to the public with the exception of the parents/guardians and teacher of the student performing; no video or audio recording permitted.
6. The chosen winners will receive scholarships toward 2023/24 VAM tuition for select eligible programs.
7. By submitting an application, students and their parent/guardian understand that any recording resulting from the competition may be used for VAM promotional purposes.
